




My name is Bill Hill. For the last 48 years God has given me wonderful opportunities to serve as an Assistant Pastor, lead a church as Senior Pastor (1987-2005) and, since 2005, direct Equipping Nationals Worldwide, an international pastoral training ministry.

Through the years, God has helped me learn and grow through His Word as well as greatly benefit from the counsel, example and influence of godly pastors — I want to do the same for others. The desire of my heart is to come alongside fellow pastors and provide help to evaluate, think through, and apply biblical principles to reach solutions to the various scenarios faced in ministry.

Following are some areas I can offer help and hope for pastors looking for the next biblical options to consider:

- 1. Helping pastors think through difficult church scenarios such as church discipline and difficult divorce cases
- 2. Assistance with difficult counseling scenarios
- Identifying and evaluating young, aspiring shepherds; thinking through the biblical process to identify their gifts, qualifications and biblical desire, and setting a plan to train them in the context of local ministry
- 4. Leadership development (identify and train men to be leaders at home and church). Where to begin, what contexts best suited for this privilege, and what material to use for this development.
- Pastoral preaching review and enrichment; scheduling sermon series for optimum personal and congregational growth; planning a preaching calendar, thinking through and discussing topics and/or books needed for congregational growth and maturity
- 6. Offering refresher studies in Homiletics and Hermeneutics



- 7. Tailoring special small groups and classes for loving accountability and relationship building
- 8. Training in Biblical Counseling and Discipleship — building a team of couples and singles who can assist the leadership by handling difficult, more advanced counseling needs as well as train other disciple makers
- 9. Developing Conflict Resolution skills and processes at the personal, family, church, and staff level
- Establishing a clear, text driven, measurable, sustainable theology of ecclesiastical ministry
- Provide pastoral friendship, encouragement, loving account ability and potential networking with other pastors for continued encouragement and ministry input
- 12. Provide help to churches looking for a pastor
- 13. Provide short term pulpit supply

Through the years, it has been my privilege to work shoulder to shoulder with men whom I have helped and from whom I have learned and been helped. They have been kind enough to give testimony of how I may be able to provide help for you. Following are the thoughts regarding Pastoral Consulting from some men God has used to strengthen my Christian Journey.




Dear Pastors and church leaders,

Dr. Bill Hill first came to the Ivory Coast to help us in 2008. Since then, he has come a total of fifteen times. Dr. Hill has helped us in two specific areas. He has taught eleven pastoral conferences for pastors who are already in full-time ministry (averaging around 30 pastors each time). As well, he has taught nine classes in our Bible institute where we have 22 men preparing for full-time ministry. Dr. Hill has instructed our pastors in the following ministerial areas:




